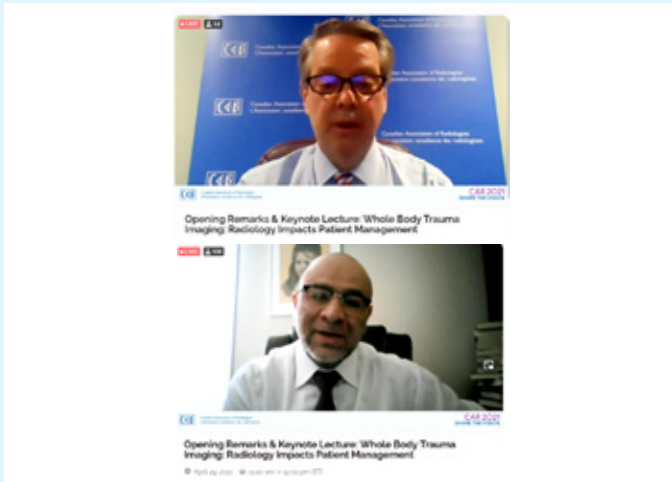

## NETWORKING

CAR 2021 provided plenty of opportunities for networking. The online conference platform offered many features to enhance the virtual experience. Delegates had the opportunity to participate in one of four receptions including the Agfa sponsored Radiologist-in-Training Speed Mentoring Session and Virtual Party, the MD Financial Management and Scotiabank sponsored Welcome Reception as well as both the Canadian Emergency, Trauma and Acute Care Radiology Society (CETARS) and the Canadian Society of Abdominal Radiology (CSAR) socials. Other features included the Virtual Lounge where colleagues could connect with one another and industry partners through video conferencing. 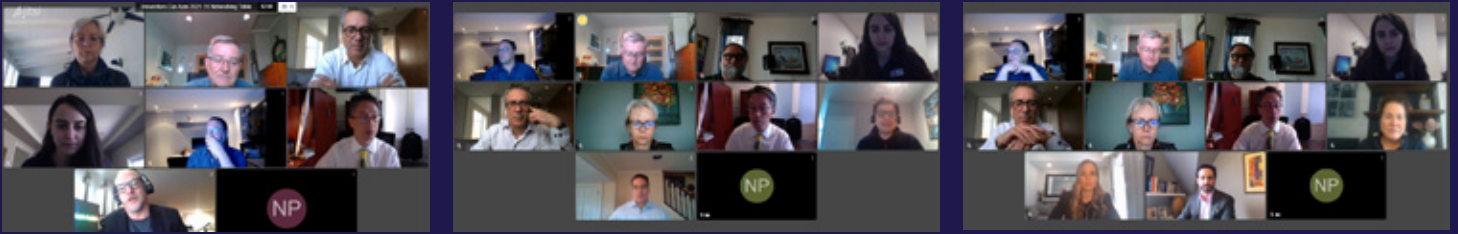

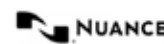
