Dr. Kate Hanneman, Associate Professor, Medical Imaging, University of Toronto

Dr. Hanneman completed medical school and diagnostic radiology residency at the University of Toronto, a cardiovascular imaging fellowship at Stanford University, and a Master's degree in Public Health in Epidemiology at Harvard University. She is currently appointed as an Associate Professor of Medical Imaging at the University of Toronto. Her clinical work focuses on cardiac CT and MRI, in addition to chest imaging. As a Clinician Scientist, she leads an active research program focused on improving health outcomes for patients with cardiomyopathies using cardiac imaging.
